Lincoln County I Rosina B. Howells do make and publish
 This^o, my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void
 All other wills by me at any time made. First^o I direct
 That my funeral expenses and all my just debts be paid as
 soon as possible out of any money that I may die possessed of
 or may come into the hands of my executors. Secondly^o I direct
 That Charles B. Howells fully pay himself
 out of any money I may die possessed of for all the trouble
 and expense he has been at with me since my sickness
 also. I direct that the said Charles B. Howells have a note of
 thirty dollars I held on him. Thirdly^o I direct that the balance
 of my money & property if any be equally divided between
 my brother Elizabeth Howell and my sister Elizabeth C.
 Howell lastly I do nominate and appoint Charles B. Howells
 my executor and to settle up all my business in writing
 whereof I do to this my will set my hand and seal this
 13th day of July 1834 *Rosina B. Howells Seal*
 Signed sealed and published in our
 presence and we have subscribed our
 names hereto in the presence of the
 testator this the 13th day of July 1834

The Good Will & Testament of Mary Staton deceased
 I Mary Staton do make and publish this my last will and
 testament hereby revoking all others and making void
 all other wills by me at any time made
 it is my will and desire that my funeral expenses and
 debts be paid and to effect this object I wish all my property
 except my slaves sold by my executors herein after named
 & the proceeds applied to the purposes aforesaid

1st I wish my three slaves Daphne, Pallas and Margaret
 hired out until the proceeds of their hire will be sufficient to
 pay all my debts after all my debts are paid I wish my
 black people disposed of as follows (to wit)

1st I give and bequeath my black girl Daphne to my
 daughter Mary McStaton to her & her heirs forever and
 I hereby appoint my son Peter McRop Guardian for my
 daughter Mary McStaton & wish him at my death to take
 said Mary McStaton & raise educate support her free
 from charge until she is twenty one years of age & to enable
 him to educate clothe & support her & so soon as my debts
 are paid I wish him to take said Daphne & keep her
 without paying any hire for her until my said daughter
 may arrive at the age of twenty one years & then deliver
 said Daphne & his increase to said Mary to belong to her &
 her heirs forever

2nd I give and bequeath my black girl Pallas
 to my son Cornelius McStaton his heirs and assigns
 for ever & I hereby appoint my son William McRop
 Guardian for my son Cornelius McStaton & wish him
 to educate clothe & said Cornelius McStaton free from
 charge expense until he is twenty one years of age &
 to enable said William McRop to educate clothe and raise
 said Cornelius McStaton as all my debts are paid
 it is my will and desire that my said son William McRop
 take said slave Pallas and keep her without paying
 any hire for her until my said son Cornelius Mc
 Staton is twenty one years of age and then deliver said
 Pallas and her increase to said Cornelius McStaton
 to belong to him his heirs and assigns forever

3rd I give and bequeath to my son Peter McRop
 his heirs and assigns forever my negro girl
