 Item 2nd I will and bequeath the house and Lot whereon I now live situated in the Town of Fayetteville Tennessee & Kennerly in the place of said Town as set out to John L. Dickson upon the following trusts ~~that~~ is to say said Dickson is to take said property into his possession after my death and rent the same and from year to year for and during the life of my son Isaac Rango said Dickson will apply to the support and maintenance of my son Isaac Rango
 Item 3rd At the death of my said son Isaac Rango I will & bequeath said property to my children John Dickson & Robert Dickson
 Item 4th I will that all the balance of my property consisting of household & kitchen furniture to be sold by my Executors the proceeds of which he will apply to the payment of my debts the residue of any he will apply to the support of my said son, Last by I do hereby appoint John Dickson my Executor.

I Sarah H. Parks of Lincoln County Tennessee do make and publish this as my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all others Wills by me at any time made
 First I desire that my funeral expenses and all my debts be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any money that I may die possessed of or may first come into the hands of my Executor
 Second, I desire that my daughter Sarah H. Parks have my one tenth interest that I have in a tract of land in the State of Tennessee County of Lincoln and District No 7 bounded as follows viz. on the North by the lands of Wiley Parley and C. H. McDaniel, East by the lands of C. B. McDaniel and Benjamin Cowley, South by the lands of William Bonner, West by the lands of Lincoln Buchanan, Mary Stark and William Parks, said tract of land estimated to contain 279 acres; the above named interests go to the payment of a note that the Guardian of Sarah H. Parks holds against me, to take effect when Sarah H. Parks arrives at the age of twenty one.
 Third— I desire that my daughter Sarah H. Parks have my Bay Horse— Fourth I desire that Martha Albany and Sarah H. Parks have my flock of sheep and studs of Hogs, and all the household and kitchen furniture.
 Fifth— I desire that all my Cattle be sold and the money go to paying my debts— I hereby nominate and appoint Wm. H. Parks my Executor, to execute this my Will— In Witness whereof I have hereunto do to this my last Will set my hand and seal, this the 6th day of February 1857
