I Abro Glack do make and publish this my  
last will and testament hereby revoking and  
making void all other wills by me at  
any time made.

First I will that my funeral expenses be paid  
Secondly All my just debts be paid as soon as possible  
after my death as possible out of any monies  
I may die possessed of or may first come into  
the hands of my executor

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my wife Amanda  
all the property and effects remaining after  
the payment of my just debts

Fourthly It is my will that my land be sold on  
one and two years time

Fifthly It is my will that the following named  
Slaves (to wit) ~~Johnston~~<sup>John</sup> Hilly and Harriet  
be reserved for the use of and benefit of my  
wife Amanda

Sixthly It is my will that all my Slaves and the  
remainder of my property be sold on twelve  
month credit except the three above mentioned  
Slaves I do hereby nominate and appoint  
James C. Garrison my executor
