

The Last Will & Testament of A. Black
I, A. Black do make and publish this my
last will and testament hereby revoking and
making void all other wills by me at
any time made.

First I will that my funeral expenses be paid
Second, I'll my just debts be paid as soon as possible
after my death as possible out of any monies
I may die possessed of or may first come into
the hands of my executor

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my wife Amanda
all the property and effects remaining after
the payment of my just debts

Fourthly It is my will that my land be ^{shall} sold on
one and two years time

Fifthly It is my will that the following named
slaves (to wit) ^{first} John, Miley and Harriet
be reserved for the use of and benefit of my
wife Amanda

Sixthly It is my will that all my slaves and the
remainder of my property be sold on twelve
month credit except the three above mentioned
slaves I do hereby nominate and appoint
James C. Harrison my executor

The Last Will of William Williams do
I, William Williams do make and publish this as
my last will and testament hereby revoking and
making void all other wills by me at any time
made. First I direct that the funeral expenses and

possible, out of any monies that I may die possessed
of or may come into the hands of my executor

Secondly I give and bequeath to my son H. S.
Williams so much of my lands to be sold by him or
my executor as will pay all his present debts

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my son H. S.
Williams and Victoria Ray the remainder of my
lands. Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint
Samuel G. Gentry my executor
