Robinson reported to guard have been returned to judgment and one awaiting the sale of said under an insolvency filed to Windup his Estate in Chancery Court at Memphis Tennessee. Said Estate will probably not pay out of it will be some time before the funds are realized on the estate. The Estate of John H. Kibbith has proved to be insolvent & is being wound up under an insolvency. Will and the two judgments are awaiting the termination of a suit in the Supreme Court. The judgments against the Administrators of James H. Kibbith is uncollected there now being no Administrators on his estate but there are arrangements made by which we think it will soon be paid. The Anderson matter in James County is yet uncollected but we think will soon be settled. All the above being in process of litigation we have not distributed the rents for the year 1880 have not been sold or distributed yet. S. J. Rogers one of the Executors retains in his hands the following sums to wit: One Note on himself amounting principal and interest at the death of Dr. John Royal to the sum of \$457.00 Also one hundred dollars of Money also \$100 in Money collected on W. B. Kibbith judgment after returning fees and the Out of being of Opinion that said Rogers is entitled to an amount as compensation for his services as said Executor up to the present time equal to the sums above returned

in his hands, hereby allows him the above amounts as such compensation and the same is thus disbursed & settled. And John C. Pyott having received such compensation for his services as Director and having had charge & control of the said estate in addition to his other duties as Director the Clerk is of opinion that his services as such Director up to the present time are fully worth the sum of fifteen hundred dollars hereby allows him the sum and directs that he may pay himself out of the first monies coming to his hands. Said Directors hope to make a final settlement upon the coming of age of the youngest child two years hence.
