The Estate of John G. Ellisper has proved to be insolvent & is being wound up under an insurmountable bill and the two judgments are awaiting the termination of a suit in the Supreme Court. The judgments against the Administrators of James H. Ellisper is uncollected there now being no Administrators on his Estate but there are arrangements made by which we think it will soon be paid. The Anderson Martin in James County is yet uncollected but we think will soon be settled all the above being in process of litigation we have not distributed the note for the year 1880 have not been sold or distributed yet.
