

WILL OF GEORGE WHITE, DECEASED

FILED MAY 17, 1887

In the name of God, Amen.

I, George White, of Memphis, Tennessee, a minister of the Gospel of Christ, being mindful, of the goodness of God, the uncertainty of life, and the certainty of death, wishing to make final disposition of my worldly effects, do make, declare, and publish this, my last will, and Testament.

Item 1st. I will, that my debts, should there be any, be paid.

Item 2nd. I give and bequeath to my daughter Tallulah L. G. White all my property, credits, and effects of every sort, and kind whatever, especially my furniture, library, notes, and my Life Insurance Policy, or certificate in the "Clergymens Mutual Insurance League" and the money to be collected thereon.

Item 3rd. I nominate and appoint my said daughter Tallulah L. G. White Executrix of this Will, and request that no bond be required of, or taken from her, as I waive her giving bond.
