Sarah Peter died } Probated Apr 26 June, 1877

I, Sarah Coates do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all other wills by me at any time made.

1st I depose that my funeral expenses and all my debts not paid at once after my death as payable out of any money that I may die possessed of.

2nd I gave and bequeathed to my son Henderson Coates one half of my said Fanna Contain in 22 gens' more - but bounded by M. C. White, John Lethy John and Thomas James the said Henderson Coates if he should die with out issue then the said Henderson Coates half of said Fanna I will and bequeathed his half or said land to James Maize Coates oldest daughter of my son James Coates

5th I will add breadth to my own James Coats the other half of my James Coats of 22 and stripes was not with to my Sam. Henderson Coats named above

4th I will and bequeath to my son James
Coats and my son Henderson Coats
all my house hold and kitchen furniture
of every kind equally between them ex-
cept and But Bed and Bed and Bed clothing
that that belongs to my son Henderson
Coats at this time
Lastly I do to this my will set my hand
and seal this the 5th day of November 1870
