Last Will and Testament of James P. Ford.
While I have strength and capacity so to do
I make and publish this my last will and
testament hereby revoking all other wills
and bequests by me hitherto made.
And first - I commend my soul to God who
gave it, and my worldly estate real personal
and mixed of which I shall die seized and
possessed of at the time of my decease.
I devise bequeath and dispose thereof in the
manner following to wit:

My will is that all my just debts and
funeral charges shall be paid by my Executors
herein after named to be paid out of my
estate as soon after my death as shall
be thought proper by said Executors.

Recognoizing it is my will and desire that
my wife Sarah being to have and to
hold and control and to use for her own
benefit all my real personal and mixed
estate that I shall own at my death
after the above bequests are completed with
further my will and desire that after
the death of my wife Sarah full
what ever property is left shall be
equally divided among my children
or their heirs.

It is further my will and desire that
F. M. Barry and C. E. Barnes be ap-
pointed my Executors.
