

Last will & Testament

of Henry C. Hicks Decd. Probated Nov. 1st 1889.

I Henry C. Hicks being ad-
mired of the uncertainty of life & the certainty of death:
and being desirous of making and arranging my tem-
poral affairs; and being of disposing mind, do make,
publish and declare this to be my last will and Testament.
Hence making null and void all other wills by me made
at any time.

1st It is my will that all my just debts and funeral
expenses be paid as soon after my death, as may be out
of the first available means that may come into the hands
of my Executor.

2nd I will & bequeath to my Son Joseph C. Hicks, the follow-
ing described tract or parcel of land, to wit: beginning
at the Ruddy Creek Road on S.P. Hicks' line and with the
same north to the top of the hill near some apple trees, thence
with or near an old fence row a westly course along
a fence part of the way to the top of a hill, thence along a
fence & a south course to the Ruddy Creek road, which includes
the field next to and adjoining the Gardner's thence with
the Ruddy Creek to the beginning, and he is to have laid
off to him one third of the timber at the south west corner
of the farm.

3rd It is my will that my daughter Mary F. Guck
have her share in my real estate laid off to her when
she now lives which share is to include, as near as may be,
about one half of the timber north of the Block-house-road
& next to George Meagrys. In laying off said share no notice
is to be taken of the buildings on the same as it was put
there by J.H. Guck.

4th It is my will that my daughter Susie A. Hickam
have her share of my real estate laid off set apart to
her adjoining her home tract on the west & is to include
a 24th acre piece of land that I bought of J.G. Hicks.

5th It is my will that the remainder of my Real estate
not included in the foregoing going bequests be equally
divided with each of my daughters, Jessie C. McCandl.
Margaret E. Doh. Annie R. Rayn. Lizzie A. Hicks.
Ellen R. Newland, & Rachel J. Rain. Provided
that in making the division of the Real estate alii natura.

Susie A. Hickam. Ellie R. Newland. Rachel J. Rain is
to have one hundred dollars less in value than the other
children named, they having two each unto her the
sum of one hundred dollars. Provided further, that
each of my said heirs above named who may take charge
of their shares before the death of my beloved wife Sarah E.
shall be required to pay a reasonable rent to my wife
during her lifetime.

It is my will that my daughter Lizzie A. Hicks &
my Son Joseph H. Hicks have of the personal effects an
allowance that will be equal to the amount that each of
my married Daughters got. And any & all other personal
effects shall go to my beloved wife.

It is my desire that the County Court appoint H.H. St.
Gaines & Ruben J. Kitton & W.F. Hicks as commissioners
to make Partition of the Real Estate herein named in
accordance with the foregoing bequests.

Conseco. It is my desire that my Executor may
make sale of a neck of land adjoining Mr. Sally on
the Nth State line, near Glen's Muddy Spring, for the pur-
pose of raising means to pay expenses &c.

It is my will & my desire that my beloved wife
is to have the old homestead herein set apart to my Son
Joseph C. Hicks, with whom she expected to live during
her lifetime.

Lastly, I hereby appoint Ruben J. Kitton my Executor
with the will annexed. Witness my hand and seal
this the 1st day of October 1889.
