

Last Will and Testament

Mrs D. M. Hughes Decd

In the name of God Amen -
I D. M. Hughes being
of sound mind disposing

mind and memory, do make, ordain and establish this
as my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all
former wills by me at any time made.

First - I give my soul to God to be disposed of
according to His good pleasure.

As to the property with which it has pleased
God to bless me, I dispose of it as follows:

First I require my executor hereinafter named
to have me buried in the cemetery an. the hill in the
East end of Bristol Tennessee or Virginia, and in
a decent and Christian like manner.

To do this I give him power and authority to pur-
chase a square or half square in said cemetery
and to pay for the same out of the effects of my
estate.

Second, I require my Executor hereinafter named
to pay all of my Just debts, and funeral expenses
as soon after my death as possible out of
any money that I may have on hand at that
time, and if this can not be done with the money
on hand, then I direct that it be done by a sale of
any of my property or the collection of any notes
or accounts due me.

Third I require him to pay A. M. Taylor who has
been my sole attorney for years the sum of five
hundred dollars for the services rendered
by him for me.

Fourth I give devise and bequeath to my nephew
W. T. Hayter of Bristol Sullivan County Tennessee
all of my property, both personal and real of
every kind and description.

My realty consists of one house and lot of about
an half acre on the corner of Main and 10th Streets
in Bristol Sullivan County Tennessee where
I now live.

Also one house and lot on Virginia Street in
Bristol Washington County Virginia.

My personal property consists mainly of notes

and accounts and my household and kitchen furni-
ture and such other articles as may be found
in my stable and other out-builds on my
lot.

I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my
nephew W. T. Hayter as the Executor of this my
last Will and Testament, and request the Court
or Courts in which this Will is offered for
probate not to require security of him as my
Executor as I have full confidence that
he will carry out the provisions of my Will
faithfully.

name and hereby declare this to be my last Will and
Testament this the 24th day of September 1892.
