

Last Will and Testament,

Malinda Barbara Hunt Decd. { Dated April June
1898

In the name of God, amen.

I Barbara Malinda Hunt being of sound mind and disposing memory hereby now make any and all former wills made by me, do hereby this my last will and testament:

First, I will my soul and body to Almighty God who created them.

Second, Out of any means that I may have on hand I will and desire that my body shall have and receive decent and Christian burial at my decease; and all of my just debts paid.

Third, I will and desire that Adam M. Hunt shall have a cupboard and a large table and a small table that he has in his in possession.

Fourth, The balance of my personal property I will and desire shall be divided equally between my brothers and sisters equally, provided that the same can be equally proportionately divided among my said brothers and sisters. But in case the said personal property cannot be amicably divided amongst the said brothers and sisters then and in that event I will and desire and direct that the same shall be sold and the proceeds of the same shall be divided equally between my brothers and sisters. But as herein after shown.

Fifth, I will and desire and direct that Geo. W. Pauer have the estate that he has in his possession provided that he will pay to the other heirs of my said estate the sum of two dollars and fifty cents. Other wise the said clerk shall be disposed of as directed in the fourth clause of this my last will and testament.

Sixth, Out of my said estate I will and desire that Malinda B. M. Barker, wife of Geo. W. Barker shall have and receive one dollar.

Seventh, Out of my personal property I will and desire that Peter Pauer shall have and

receive one dollar and an acre that he has now in his possession.

All my dishes and table ware and linen will and desire shall be given to Sarah C. Pauer my sister the wife of Solomon P. Pauer.

I will and desire that my said sister Sarah Pauer shall have my new Bradfield feather bed and the necessary bed clothing for the same.

I will and desire that Sarah C. Pauer shall have one of my shirts, she to have choice of the same, and that the other two shirts shall be given one each to Peter Pauer and Geo. W. Pauer.

Twelfth, All of my other personal property not herein before disposed of I hereby will, desire and direct to be given and delivered to Sarah C. Pauer wife of the said Solomon P. Pauer, wife of the said Solomon P. Pauer. That is each article that her husband may have in their possession at my death.

Thirteenth, Out of any moneys I may have on hand after paying my funeral expenses and my just debts I will and desire and direct that the sum of one dollar in cash be paid to Kansas Hunt daughter of a M. Hunt.

I specially will and desire that Adam M. Hunt shall have my Bible.

Fourteenth, I will and desire that the said Sarah C. Pauer shall have the bureau that is in the house of her husband Solomon P. Pauer, and that Peter Pauer shall have the safe of mine that is in said house that is, the house of said Solomon P. Pauer.

Fifteenth, Inasmuch as my estate is small and my brothers George Barker and Peter Hunt are now in distant States, and as it would be more expensive than profit to let them share in my estate, I hereby will, desire and direct that they shall not have any of my said estate.

I hereby nominate and appoint Adam M. Hunt as the executor of this

my last will and testament and without
executing a bond for same.
