I give and bequeath to my son David Bushong the balance of the farm on which I now live after my wife shall have received the tract of 100 acres set apart for her. Also together with my residence, all the barns, outhouses and other out houses belonging and pertaining thereto.

I also give and bequeath all the balance of my personal property household furniture, farming implements, stock, tool, chaise, in action and valuable of every description not heretofore disposed of my son David Bushong & whom hereby appoint my ordinary Legatee and executor of this my last will and testament.

Last Will and Testament of James W. Miller

I, James W. Miller do make
and publish this my last
will and testament hereby revoking and making
void all others by me at any time made.

First I direct that my funeral expenses and all my debts be paid as soon after my death

as possible out of any moneys that I may die possessed of or may first come into the hands of my executor.

Secondly I will and direct that my land be sold at private sale by my executors for the best price that they can get one-half of the purchase money paid when sold the remainder in such time as agreed upon by my executor not to exceed one or two years from date of sale retaining a lease on the same for the purchase money.

Third that my executors sell all my Personally property also at private sale in such times as they think best except my bed and furniture and my clock which I will to my Daughter Ellen Burnett.

Fourth I will and direct that out of the proceeds of the sales that my executors pay me - hundred dollars to my daughter Mary Jane Campbell her - hundred dollars to my daughter Martha Miller:

one hundred dollars to my Daughter Sarah Ann Burnett. One hundred dollars to my daughter Ellen Burnett.

I have heretofore sold land to my other three children to wit: Abram H. Miller R. S. Miller James Campbell to the amount of one hundred dollars each.

Fifth I direct that after paying of what I have heretofore directed the remainder if any to be equally

divided among all my heirs by my executors. Lastly - I do hereby nominate and appoint Abram H. Miller and John Burnett my Executors.
