

any time hereafter made.

First, I direct that all my debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as possible out of the first moneys that shall come into the hands of my executor.

Second I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sallie a certain white cow, and two hogs being now in the pen.

Third, I direct that the rents of all my lands be paid to my daughter Sallie so long as she remains single. After which the proceeds of said land to be equally divided among all of my children.

Fourth, I direct that all of my household and kitchen furniture be equally divided among all of my children. Also a lot of Cabin which I also now possessed of unless I should sell said Cabin before my decease.

Fifthly, I direct that any other property not herein mentioned which I am possessed of shall be sold either publicly or privately and the proceeds of the sale be equal divided among all my children.

Sixthly, I direct that the interest accruing due me be collected and that my debts and funeral expenses be paid out of said money, and the remainder be divided equally among all of my children.

Seventhly, I direct and appoint my son Noah Gallaway my executor of this my last will and testament and that he be not required to give a bond.

I signed sealed and delivered by the said Wiley Gallaway to be his last will and testament in the presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses in the presence of the testator.

As to my four other sons Jacob George Isaac and Leckard I have given them this portion hereof of my estate already.

I do hereby nominate and appoint Jacob D. Welford my executor. In witness whereof I do to this my will set my hand and seal this 1st day of March in the year of our Lord 1877.
