come into the hands of my executor.

Second. I give and bequeath to my son William Mill-
house a tract of land lying in the 18th Cen-
sor of Sullivan County, New York, adjoining the land
of A. J. Bachman and others holding the farm on
which I now live and it is my will and I
hereby direct that my son William Millhouse
shall furnish my daughter Eliza Millhouse
a comfortable room in the mansion house
including a respectable living so long as
she remains single, but in the event she
marries then and in that event William
Millhouse is not to be charged with furnishing
her any longer.

Third
I give to my son Will Millhouse all my
personal property of every kind including
debts due me at my death.

Fourth
It is my will and I hereby direct that
William Millhouse shall pay to each one
of my heirs the sum of ten dollars
as I have by nominate and appoint my

son William Millhouse my executor and it is my
will that he cover with his hand in witness
whereof I do this my will set my hand and seal
