

Church South for the use of the superannuated and worn out ministers of the Methodist Church within the bounds of the Holston Conference
I give and bequeath the sum of one hundred dollars one bed and bed clothing
one Cow & calf to Elizabeth Garner Ford, but this bequest is not to be executed
if my Executrix alsp the said Elizabeth Garner Ford shall conduct herself in
a disorderly and riotous manner and remain with me and my wife or my wid-
ow in the event of my death, until she shall arrive at the age of twenty one
years, also said Executrix is not permitted to pay over to any except a duly ap-
pointed Guardian the said sum of one hundred dollars, I give and bequeath
the sum of twenty dollars, one bed and bed clothing to Rhoda Emma Ford
but this bequest is indomitable and depends upon the same conditions as the
above bequest to the said Elizabeth Garner Ford, & it is my will that my Executrix
after my death and after the sale of my personal property shall first pay my
just debts & then I give anything standing he shall pay the fifty dollars leg-
acy, 3rd if he shall pay the legacy to Elizabeth Garner Ford, 4th if he shall pay
the legacy to Rhoda Emma Ford, 5th if he pay the remainder if any there be to my
wife should she survive me.

I appoint my Friend William Wofford my Executrix of this my last will and
Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my name making my mark
and affix my seal this 18th day of March 1868,

Will Of Sarah Thatcher

I Sarah T. Thatcher of the County of Sullivan State of Tennessee being in full
health, but of sound mind and willing to make and publish this as my last will
and Testament hereby revoking all or any former wills by me at any time made
1st It is my will and desire that my just debts and funeral expenses be paid
as soon after my death as possible out of my Estate.

Second it is my will and desire that my negro man judge shall be free before
him a faithful and obedient servant and it has been my determination for years
to give him his freedom at my death in consideration of his fidelity and obedi-
ence to my orders, and wishes. I therefore now declare that he shall be free
at my death, and all the privileges that free persons of color are entitled to un-
der the laws of the state. As regards my other slaves freedom and service
and such personal property as I am possessed of, I at present make no de-
position of but leave the same to be disposed of among my relatives as the law
permits. In Testimony whereof I subscribe my name and affix

Will Of Jacob Slaughter

I Jacob Slaughter being of sound mind and disposing memory doth re-
cite and declare this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all other wills
herefore made by me. 1st I will my soul unto God who gave it. 2nd I will
and direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid and that my body
be decently interred. 3rd I will and direct that after my just debts are paid that daughters
Baby Catherine Bailey and my two sons John and William have my two acres tract
of land lying in Sullivan County and adjoining the lands of Thos White and John
Hearley together with all the improvements thereon & all my personal property
of every kind and description except the legacy herein after bequeathed. I further
will & direct that my above named three daughters & two sons shall live together &
John & William are not to care either of my daughters to leave their home, and should by
misfortun either of the girls, we are to cause them or any one of them to have to leave, then
the one so offending shall forfeit his entire interest in my estate and the interest there
shall go to the three girls alone namely, I will and direct that my three daughters shall
have a home at my home stead so long as they live or until they should marry or otherwise
voluntarily absent themselves, I further will to my sons Jacob and Jacob and
my daughter Mary Rogers and Sally McElroy shall be paid one dollar each out of
my estate to be paid to them out of any money expended at my death by my Ex-
ecutrix. 5th I hereby nominate and appoint my two sons William and John Slaughter
my Executrix to this my last will and Testament.
