 Tennessee do make and publish this my
 last will and testament hereby revoking
 all former wills by me at any time
 made

1st I direct that all my just debts including
 funeral expenses and expenses of ad-
 ministrations be paid by my Executor

2nd I give devise and bequeath to my be-
 loved wife Colin B. Smith my house and
 lot now occupied by me as a residence
 at no 110 Fifth Street, Benton Tenn
 together with all the household goods
 and furniture contained therein.

3rd The remainder of my property both
 real and personal I give devise and
 bequeath to my wife Colin B. Smith
 my two daughters Eva B. and Mary
 Dillard my son Wm. Fulton to be
 avowed by them jointly each among
 one undivided fourth thereof.

4th I hereby nominate and appoint Colin
 B. Smith sole Executor of this my
 last will and testament and I set
 the Court to relieve him from giving
 bond.
