The last Will In the name of Almighty God Amen
I Thomas Gatture being weak in body,
of sound mind and memory and
in view of the shortness of life, and the
certainty of death do make and publish this my last will
and testament in the words and figures following that
is to say I give back my soul to God who gave it
and my body to the earth from whence it came and
that my body shall have a decent Christian burial and
my funeral expenses paid out of any means in hand at
the time of my death.

It is my will and desire that my brother James
Gatture shall have full power and control of all the land
we now own and have in our possession both in
Sullivan County and State of Yonkers and Scott County
Virginia together with the proceeds and rents of the same
for the support of himself and his two sisters Eliza
Abigail Gatture and Susanna Gatture. And all the unincor-
porated household and kitchen furniture of every kind
and character whatsoever either in beds and bedding
one Clock, tables or anything else connected therewith
all the stock of horses cattle sheep and pigs which
may be on the farm all the farming utensil
charioting in wagons plows hoes and harrows to set Black-
smith tools, all the bars on hand also sets of saws
etc grist mill stones etc and one pair of mill stones etc

to have and to hold the same during his natural lifetime
It is my will and desire after the death of my beloved
brother James Gatture that my undivided interest in the
different tracts of lands which I am lawfully seized and
possessed of, by deed and the devise of my father will be
fully set forth by wills Wounds in said titles shall devi-
de to my beloved brother Joseph Gatture and his heirs
forever. Also all my undivided interest in all the personal
property of every kind to have and to hold the same.

It is further specified and provided that my said belov-
ed brother Joseph Gatture shall take immediate possession
of the lands which I have this day bequeathed unto him
and his heirs forever at the death of my said brother James
Gatture.

In order to give out this my last will and testam-
ent I nominate and appoint James M. Gatture my sole
executrix and attorney at law in my will or wills by me made at any
time and publishing this to be my last will and testament
in the presence of us subscribers witness

the 21st day of Month 1840
