Virginia Preston Carrington decd. I Virginia Preston Carrington do declare this to be my last will and Testament:

First. I give devise and bequeath all my property, both real and personal to my Nephew Campbell C. Cochran.

Second: I appoint said Campbell C. Cochran the Executor of this my last will and revoke all other wills by me made.

In witness whereof I have to this my last will and testament consisting of one sheet of paper subscribed my name at the City of Duluth in the State of Minnesota this 30th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight.

I Samuel Vance do make and publish this as my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all other wills by me at any time made first I direct that after my death and the death of my wife Sarah Vance the same as which I now live and the wood land belonging to me lying on the south side of Holston river and the waters of meadow creek both be sold and the money equally divided betwixt all my children namely Harriet Sharp, John Vance, Mary Denton, Sarah Pierce, Franklin, Josiah Peters & Martha Montgomery in witness whereof I do to this my will set my hand & seal this the 23 day of November 1893 signed sealed and published in our presence and we have subscribed our names hereto in the presence of the testators this the 23 day of November 1893
