shall take and have absolutely all of the land or real  
estate which or that I may die seized and possessed of.

and description.

Item fourth I direct that my executors shall collect  
all debts due me upon such terms as he may deem  
best after my death.

Item fifth It is my will and desire that this my last  
will and testament be read at the grave yard the day  
that I am buried by my executors.
