Be it known by all men that I do make

part of my estate. This amount including

5th I want my sons and daughters, not
mentioned in this will to have the sum
of one dollar each.

6th I desire to be buried in the Baldwin
Cemetery beside my wife and shall have
tomb stones erected at my grave at an
ordinary expense by my daughters Cordie
Jones and Julia Hashbarger, provided they
are not erected by the order of administrator.

7th I appoint Dr. Geo. G. Keener for my
administrator and he shall hold this will
and at death shall wind up my assets
as soon as possible.
