First

It is my will that my body shall be decently buried after my death in or christian like manner in the Family Grave yard on the premises where I live

Secondly

I will that all my just debts be paid out of my personal property and effects if sufficient to pay the same and if not I hereby empower and direct my Executor hereafter named to sell a portion of my real Estate for that purpose if it becomes necessary to do so at private Sale and make title there to

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Thirdly

I will and bequeath the tract of land I now own whereon I now live supposed to be about one hundred acres more or less to my beloved wife Mary T. O'Brien during her natural life and after her death it is my will that said tract of land shall decent to my Son Samuel M. O'Brien and his heirs in fee simple forever

Fourthly

It is my will that Julia O'Brien a Girl that I have raised shall live with my wife during her good behavior and be supported off of the Farm I have a cow willed to my beloved Wife as one of

my Son Samuel M O'Brien and his heirs in fee Simple forever

Fourthly

It is my will that Julia O'Brien a Girl that I have raised shall live with my wife during her good behavior and be supported off of the Farm I have a bond willed to my beloved Wife as one of the family until she the said Julia shall marry after which time said support and maintenance shall cease

Fifthly

It is my will that Mr Emmet shall be my Executor and I hereby nominate and constitute and appoint him as my said Executor and I hereby direct and empower him after my death to see that this my will and Testament shall be carried out in every particular
