T. Erwin Attorney in fact for Samuel C. Erwin Containing by estimation Two Hundred and Thirty Six Acres more or less and for which I and my ^{said} Son Robert Birchfield paid the Sum of Two Thousand Dollars Robert paying One Hundred ~~and~~ Sixty five Dollars of the original purchase money

3rd

I Will and bequeath To my Son Jesse Birchfield One Hundred Dollars to be paid by my Son Robert in a good horse or money to any other good trade

Hundred Dollars To be paid by my Son Robert in a good horse or money or any other good trade

4th

I will and bequeath To my Son David Burchfield One Hundred and Thirty five Dollars To be paid by my Son Robert in a good horse or any other good trade

5th

I will and bequeath To The Children of my Daughter Sarah Landreth Deceased To wit Henry Jipe John and Franklin Landreth Twenty Five Dollars To be paid in good Trade and To be equally divided between them The Same To be paid by my Son Robert I having heretofore paid them said heirs their Share of my estate

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6th

I will and bequeath To my Daughter Mary J Pinner or her Heirs Forty Dollars To be paid by my Son Robert in good Trade I having heretofore paid her and her husband their Shares of my Estate

7th

I will and bequeath To my Daughter E Angelina Williams Seventy five Dollars To be paid by my Son Robert in good Trade

8th

I will and bequeath my Grand children the heirs of my Daughter Judith McLaughlin Deceased To wit William McLaughlin Mollie Erwin wife of Jesse Erwin and George C. McLaughlin the sum of one dollar each to be paid by my son Robert in good trade I having heretofore paid my said Daughter and her husband Nelson McLaughlin her share of my Estate

9th

I will and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth wife of Garret Ray one dollar to be paid by my son Robert in good Trade I having paid my said daughter Elizabeth and her said husband their part share of my estate

10th

I will and bequeath my son William Burchfield one dollar to be paid by my son Robert in good Trade I having paid him his share of my Estate

11th

I will and bequeath to my son Robert all the personal property household and kitchen furniture of every kind and description whatever that I may own at the time of my death and I will leave it unto him that he shall

I hereby nominate and appoint my tried and trusty friend
S. J. St. Germain my Executor to execute this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking and annulling all wills heretofore
made by me
