Owing to the condition of the County Cases
 by the War and owing to there being some
 suits in the Chancery Court at a point pending
 against said Estate the said Administrator
 The Present cannot collect the money on the
 notes for the hire of the slaves before referred to
 he therefore respectfully requests the worshipful
 Court to allow him a further time of one year
 to wind up said Estate said Administrator
 taken charge of the slaves before referred to some
 & Harry and hired them out some to be sold
 as directed by Law and continued to do so
 untill the Day Tom ran off to the army & said
 Mary ceased to be a slave and is freed the said
 Administrator therefore discharges the Court of his
 Release from further Responsibility of said slaves
 which comes a balance in the hands of said
 Administrator due said Estate of six Hundred
 and Dollars and four fiftymix Dollars and
 forty four cents \$659.44
