 The uncertainty of this mortal life, and the
 certainty of death do make certain and
 publish the following, as my last will
 and testament hereby revoking all former
 wills by me at any time made and
 now being of sound mind and memory
 I do will and bequeath my soul to God
 who give it - 2^d I will bequeath and devise
 not as I am after my death as my
 Executors hereinafter named may think
 advisable that all of my estate both
 real and personal be sold except what
 may be in money notes and accounts &c
 the personal property to be twelve month
 time or all longer for the amount of five
 dollars and cents and in all other
 under five dollars to be paid as my
 creditors may require and that prob
 and approval. Security be taken having
 interest at six per cent per annum
 from date of sale for the same
 and that my real estate all that I
 may own either by legal or by contract
 be sold on a credit of one and
 two years in equal sums except
 the sum of ten per cent - and the same
 amount - bid which sum shall be
 paid in hand notes with approval
 security will be taken and a lien
 retained on all the lands until all
 is fully paid the notes to bear interest
 at 6 per cent per annum until paid
 some date of sale 3rd I want all
 sums due or owing to me collected
 by my Executors and out of the
 proceeds of sale of property or my
 money & may have been hand
 at time of my death I want all
 my just legal debts and funeral

Expenses and 4th After my Executors
 have collected the money for all
 the above mentioned debts - debts
 and accounts as also all moneys
 I may have or have of my estate
 and after the payment of the above
 mentioned debts if any and should
 remain that they be set out to the
 aggregate sum left to me some two
 hundred dollars 20th which said
 sum I will once in six months coming
 interest Grand daughter Alice Horton
 which sum I want placed in the
 hands of my son John & Simonson
 as trustee and that he will pay
 the same at interest until he will
 Grand daughter Alice Horton is
 twenty one years old and that at
 that time he pay it over to her and
 all the interest which has accrued
 upon the same until the said
 Alice Horton should come of age she
 arriving at twenty one years having
 issue or not being surviving or
 dead no sum to her share but if
 she leaves no issue surviving her
 then the two hundred dollars and interest
 on same as above stated revert
 to me & to the Common Land and
 be equally divided among my sur
 viving after named who may be
 living or to the heirs of the body of her
 who may be dead provided there who
 may be dead may have heirs or
 only surviving them, but I will not
 bequeath that after the above mentioned
 sums are taken from the total
 remainder of my estate that the
 balance be equally divided between
 my children namely John & Simonson

Edward Simpson, my son
 and the same John and Thomas
 Simpson but I give of the said
 children be dead having being said
 to the wife then the name to take in
 and portions the part their parents
 would take it being that I request
 that if I should die before my business
 as Vice & Master of the Chancery
 Court - of - Somerset - Devonshire the
 fully settled and wound up that
 my eldest son George of my interest
 in the said business with the assistance
 of a Solicitor that he settle and collect
 all sums which I may be entitled
 to as such Vice Commissioner
 or otherwise and account with my
 Executors for the same in keeping
 an itemized statement of all his
 actions in the premises I would
 authorize the selling of my house place
 in two parcels as the best way of raising
 of small means would more likely
 being my Executors my after due
 reduction sell any or all of the above
 mentioned estate either at Public or
 private Sale or on Shorter or longer
 time than above mentioned but must
 sell in the way and manner which
 will realize the largest amount - to
 my heirs as may appear to them
 from all the surrounding Circumstances
 and I appoint my two Sons John &
 Simpson and Edward V. Simpson
 and W. H. Hall - my Executors of this my
 last will and release them from giving
 bond and security but require them to settle
 and account to and with each other
 made March 22nd 1885
