my dwelling house for lifetime & the Negro with all the remainder of household furniture
to be divided between her and my daughter Martha Likewise allow her of the sum
one hundred bushels of wheat and twenty of corn young for her self & that I likewise
bequeath to my daughter Martha my Negro boy named Tom and of he shall be
in no wise answerable for his property I do allow him fifty pounds on his & her I likewise
leave her twenty pounds on each with a horse and saddle worth twenty five pounds
I bequeath to my son Joseph the half of all the land I possess I likewise
bequeath to all my grand children that is born on this side the river that is to say

me in full twenty dollars cash to be paid out of the first money that is made & otherwise do
appertain to my son in law Alexander McLean four hundred pounds Likewise do allow my son William
my house boy Robert Dennis during his time to be with me & Likewise do allow the remaining
& my house estate both real and personal to be equally divided to all my sons & Likewise
out of his estate and before my son John Blair and Alexander McLean my sole executors of this my
last will and testament are I do hereby utterly renounce & disown all and every other former
testament wills legacies bequests and executors by me in any way before him or myself made and
equally ratifying and confirming his are no other to be my last will and testament — In

the business in a decent and Christian like manner at the discretion of my executors —
desire as to such worldly estate wherewithal I have pleased god to bless me in this life I do desire

I do hereby constitute and appoint William Barnard my son John Blair & my wife Hannah Blair to be the executors of this my last will and testament — Signed sealed and ratified in the presence of us.
