Beth having her before me till her death to be the property of my son Jerry White should he be living &
all my household goods and furnishings I leave to my wife & son Jerry & his issue of that pleasure
Him. I give and bequeath to my son Jerry my two Negro boys Namie Tom and Ned together
with all stock of horses cattle sheep & hogs furnishings utensils etc & every other article
belonging to me Next otherwise of what he is to have my wife with a house to reside in
safely at all times when she shall choose or want at her ease, pleasure and a lot to gear her
in sufficient and decent apparel and out during her life in continuance to divide with him
and also to pay after the death of my wife to my son William Fisher Radnor one to my
daughter Mary wife of Thomas Gibson second wife of Daniel Denton (late wife to
Elijah) from the sum of one hundred dollars each — also as these hundred given
and conveyed to my other sons their portion in kind. Thirdly I bequeath the several sums given or
their part of my estate — Lastly I nominate and appoint my beloved wife & my
son Jerry Denton to be executors of this my last will & testament. hereby revoking &
disannulling all other wills legacies and bequests by me heretofore made and making this
