

Hugh Campbell Will

In the Name of God Amen

The twentieth day of October Anno Domini 1770 Hugh Campbell of
 Washington North Carolina being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks
 be given unto God therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed
 for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & testament that is to say
 principally and first of all I give & bequeath my soul into the hands of God who gave it
 and for my body I commend it to the earth to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner
 at the discretion of my executor nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall
 receive the same again by the mighty power of God - and as touching such worldly estate
 wherein I have pleased God to bless me in this life: I give devise & dispose of the
 same in the following manner & form - Impium It is my will and I do hereby
 that in the first place all my debt debts & financial charges be paid & satisfied
 Item It is my will and I do devise my plantation to be equally divided by my executors
 between my two wife beloved sons Hugh & Robert which tract of land when divided
 I give & bequeath to my said sons of course in the following manner (to wit)
 I give & bequeath to my wife beloved son Hugh that part of the plantation on
 which stands my Mansion house and other out houses to him his heirs & assigns
 for ever remaining to my dear beloved wife a comfortable maintenance off the
 said plantation one half of my land during her Natural lifetime It is my will
 as I bequeath and give to my beloved son Robert the other a remaining half
 of the house he lives in now stands of my plantation to him his heirs and
 assigns for ever; I do also give and bequeath to my son Robert upon the death of my
 dear wife Item I do further give & bequeath to my said wife beloved wife my gray
 Mare to her sole use & behoof and to be supported by my son Hugh
 Item I do give and bequeath to my wife beloved daughter Sarah one half of all my
 household furniture and the young stock and four cattle that she has already claimed as her
 part; three cows a steer & a Bull which cattle are all to be left in the plantation with
 the rest by my son Hugh whilst the family continues together - help my dear
daughter Sarah choose to dispose of them otherwise or soon
 Item It is my will and I do bequeath to my son Samuel the horse and boy fully
 set out to be disposed of by him at any time without the consent of the executors of his will
 as whist he my son Samuel is willing to live with his Mother and family as a part of
 the family it is my will that he have his Maintenance from them & if at any time
 hereafter it should appear to my executors that it would be fit that I ought that my
 son Samuel should have a plantation of his own except when to live I own it &
 it is my will that my two sons Robert & Hugh pay a sum at the discretion of my
 executors but not to exceed one third of the value of my plantation for the purpose
 of purchasing a plantation for them both Samuel and the purchase I request my
 executors to make if they think it necessary to be done which plantation if purchased I do
 not allow my son Samuel to have a right to dispose of without consent of my
 executors - Item It is my will & I do give the boy horse and the other half of the horse
 and furniture to remain on the place for the use of the family whilst they live together
 and when they shall be divided to be divided in like manner

It is my will and I further give that all the rest of my personal estate be and remain
 on that part of my plantation which I have given to my son Hugh for the best benefit of my
 wife & family that may live with her until he decease and at the decease of my dear wife
 in my will and I do give the said personal estate to be left to be equally divided & given equally to my two
 sons Robert and Hugh to their own use & behoof I do hereby nominate & appoint my wife & wife
 beloved friends and my constituents and executors John Abernethy & Thomas Cooper and John Campbell
 executors of this my last will and testament In writing whereof I the said Hugh Campbell
 have to this my last will and testament set my hand this day & year above written
 signed sealed & declared by the said Hugh Campbell the testator as his last will and testament
 in the presence of us who were present at the time of signing and sealing thereof

Andrew Duncanson Will

Memorandum of Andrew Duncanson last will & testament is as follows. That I do request that
 my two beloved wife sons all the household furniture to me as his pleasure & to be at the
 discretion of his executors & the land during his widowhood likewise be given to
 my dear wife which she shall choose out of Mr. Stone's together with her several & private
 together with her cow & calf or her share out of the stock - I likewise leave
 the plantation in the hands of my son Andrew who is to take the care of the same
 and to have the care & sight of the younger children who are all to labour together
 and to have their schooling & maintenance of the land which the only
 shall marry at which time each girl shall have out of Mr. Mowatt's estate an
 hour and small and other necessary as near as possible to the portion of three
 of my daughter already married remembering that the house and barn must
 be repaired out of the stock that now is and all my lawful debt is paid Those
 of my daughter who are married have got their portions already which I allowed
 to them and I allow them no part of my estate which is remaining I likewise
 will my land should be divided equally amongst the boys except my son Samuel
 which he has already got is to be deducted out of his part of the land
