

David Lemon Will

In the Name of God Amen

I David Lemon of Washington County State of Tennessee  
of sound mind and memory (blessed be god do this) fourteenth day of August anno Domini  
eight hundred & seventy five, make and publish this my last will & testaments in the  
Manner following that is to say, I having sold my land to John Lemon & Jacob  
Lemon and is to take it in trust and Joseph Lemon is to have fifteen dollars out of  
the price of my land & Abraham Lemon is to have one hundred & forty dollars when  
this wife Sarah is to have one hundred and forty dollars and said Barnes wife  
Elizabeth is to have one hundred & thirty dollars out of my said land my son David  
Lemon John Lemon & Jacob Lemon having divided their parts in full of my  
real & personal estate and Joseph Lemon Abraham Lemon John his wife &  
Jacob Barnes wife is to take their parts of the pay that is coming to them out  
of the land at the same rates that I was to get it from John & Jacob  
Lemon John Lemon having paid Christian Lemon Manuel Lemon Joseph  
Lemon Penny black iron parts of the land. I paid Joseph Lemon one hundred  
dollars for his part of the land and John Lemon paid him twenty five dollars  
leaving him the above fifty two dollars in the price of the land. My wife clothing & the  
Dinner that is on hand is for my daughter Jacob Barnes wife Elizabeth at my  
decease and all the personal estate that I may leave at my decease is to be  
left by executors hereof in two parts & equally divided among my heirs  
except John David & Jacob Lemons and I do hereby make and beleave my  
worthy friend John Milleron Executor of this my last will & testaments —  
In witness whereof I the said David Lemon have to this my last will  
and testaments set my hand and seal the day & date above written —  
Signed sealed published & declared by the said David Lemon the testator as his  
last will & testaments in the presence of who are present at the time of signing and

paid and my unusefull debts be paid. I will & bequeath that my plantation be  
left to my wife Sarah also my young Rose Men & two Hounds of her own  
choosing four head of hogs of her choosing and four head of sheep of her  
choosing and all the household and Kitchen furniture and all the eas and  
all my farmery fixtures which she is to have during her life at her  
death the plantation shall be sold and the property that is left to my  
wife shall be sold and divided equally between my four children Thomas  
Frank Aaron Finch Sarah Betsy & Mary Baylis I will & bequeath  
that the balance of my property be divided equally between my four children  
Kasius in the wife I will and bequeath that her a board girl have one leather  
bed of my Stock when she arrives to the age of eighteen years of age and a  
feather bed given under my hand & seal August 14th 1829

they are to make an equal share of the said property at my death if they  
can all agree of not, they are then with my wife and bequeath to make  
settle of all the property and then divide the same
