John Hammon Will

This my last will & testament

In the name of God amen. I John Hammon of Washington County & State of Pennsylvania being in perfect health of body & sound memory doth be given to god Almighty to know the Mortality of my body & knowing that it is apter for all man kind to die as Men & Beasts the my last will & testament that is to say first of all I give & recommend my soul unto the hand of Almighty god that gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my executors Nothing dreading but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly estate wherewithal I have placed God to help me in this life. I give, devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and from First I give and bequeath to Margaret my dearly beloved wife the whole plantation that I now live on with all the improvements on or which a she may think fittest during her natural life to maintain her with one good house & one good law two good feather beds one clock one sofa & all her household furniture & bed clothes & books. Also give to my well beloved son Isaac Hammon & John Hammon & Jonathan Hammon & Lydia Hammon two dollars to every one of them his dollars in all as they have been already benefitted by leases and gifts I give to Jonathan Hammon's beloved son John my beloved son before any marriage companion & my bedchamber tools & my share of the Crooked Lane as my death bed I give her one good feather bed & bed clothes that is to Jonathan Hammon to one and John Hammon. Also give to my well beloved daughters Barbara Range & Elizabeth Kelly & Mary Bogart my whole estate real and personal to be equally divided among my three daughters & their heirs of any & then their heirs & executors that their lawful heirs shall be intitled to their Mother's part. Note this is not to affect any part parcel of my estate alwaying Mr. & Co. to any person by leases or grants but that the same money be accounted that nothing be misconstrued for want of words or wrong spelling. Also constitute make & ordain the sole executors of this my last will & testaments that Samuel Bogart Jr and James White and I do here by utterly disallow revoke & disannul all & every other former Testaments wills or legacies by me in any wise before named or made but this to my last will & testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 10th day of February in the year of our Lord 1816 One thousand eight hundred & sixteen years ago as published pronounced declared by the said John Hammon who in his presence have hereunto subscribed our names

Peter Range Will

In the Name of God Amen

Peter Range of the State of Pennsylvania & County of Washington being weak and low in health but in sound mind & memory thereto be given to god Almighty unto Mere the Mortality of my body & knowing that it is opportune for me now come to die do make & ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul unto heaven of Almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my executors & as touching such worldly estate wherewithal it has pleased God to help me in this life I give, devise & dispose of the same in the following manner & form—First I give & bequeath to my beloved son Isaac my plantation with all other plantations belonging thereto as in the same case is to keep my wife his widow wife with her and to her heirs a trader for while there Mother also it is likely will & leave that he shall keep my three daughters Barbara, Sarah & Rachel as long as the keep so far & use them as a trader brother ought to use his sisters it is also my desire that Isaac pay my son Peter one thousand dollars in the term of five years & he shall be to let Peter enjoy that part of the plantation when he now lives until he pays him the money. Furthermore I give and bequeath all money that is in my possession or due to me to my son Isaac to be paid to him it is also my desire that Isaac pay my son Isaac his husband as either & one thousand dollars & back to the worth of one thousand dollars to be paid to him in two years from the time of the sale of property. Furthermore I give & bequeath to my three daughters Barbara, Sarah & Rachel each of them a good bed and all the rest of my household furniture & chattels I want sold and one thousand dollars to the money arising from the sale I give & bequeath to my beloved wife the other two thirds of the money to go to my daughters allowing them an equal part but my three daughters that now live with me Barbara, Sarah & Rachel to have one thousand dollars more than the rest to make them equal with the others it is also my request that Isaac pay my son John one dollar as he has already got his part that I now have — Lastly I make constitute & ordain my son John and Isaac to be my executors of this my last will & testament I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & annul and every other former testament ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament. In witness whereof these presents I have signed & sealed this 10th day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixteen.
