Nicholas Kufharer Will.

The last will and testament of Nicholas Kufharer
I Nicholas Kufharer do make and publish
this my last will and testament hereby revoking
and making void all other wills by me at
any time made.

First - I direct that at my death my
body be decently buried and that my funeral
expences and last my just debts be paid out of
any money that I may be possessed of or
may first come into the hands of my Executor as
soon after my death as possible.

Secondly - I give and bequeath to my beloved
wife Catharine Kufharer my dwelling house and
garden and her the choice of all my negroes and
one hundred Dollars in money and as much of the
household furniture as she may desire to keep
in her possession and such of the kitchen furniture
as she may need and all my German Books
to have and to hold to her during her natural
life and whatever is left at her death to return to
my lawful heirs.

Thirdly - I give and bequeath to my daughter
Elizabeth Arnold five hundred Dollars in money
in lieu of her portion of land beside one hundred
and forty Dollars that I have already given to
her making in all six hundred and forty
Dollars

Fourthly - I give and bequeath to the heirs at law
of my son Henry Kufharer lately deceased the
part of my farm where the late Henry Kufharer
lived as far toward my house as a conditional
line lately marked out by me from James
line to James Kullens line by my son Nicholas pay-
ing out of his own money to the said heirs of
the late Henry Kufharer four hundred dollars in
money - then my son Nicholas is to have all the rest
of the land from the said conditional line on the
side next to Hamptons and Dacens but the possession
is to remain in the hands of my wife to maintain her
during her lifetime and and as little to be made to
Nicholas Kufharer portion only subject to the said
Catharine Kufharers life estate in his portion of the
land but at her death he is to go into the full
possession of that portion of my land and this I
consider as a fair division of my land among
my heirs.

Fifthly - I give and bequeath to my children
Elizabeth Arnold, Nicholas Kufharer and the
heirs at law of Henry Kufharer deceased an equal
division of all my other property the negroes to
be divided but not sold out of the families of my
children and if should happen in dividing the slaves
that they cannot be divided so as to make all my
heirs equal then those getting the most valuable must
pay to the rest so as to make all equal and what
money may remain after all payments of debts and
bequests to be equally divided among my heirs at law.

Lastly - I hereby nominate and appoint my son Nicholas Kufharer my Executor
to carry this will into effect in witness whereof I do this my last will
& testament at my hand and seal this 3^d day of March 1837
