Mary Rector ten dollars I do also give and bequeath unto William Hartman son of my second daughter Jane Hartman ten dollars I do also give and bequeath to William Oakens son of my fourth daughter Ann Oakens ten dollars I do also give and bequeath unto William Hunt son of my fifth daughter ten dollars I do also give and bequeath unto my daughter in law Tracy Walker ten dollars

I do also give and bequeath to my daughter in law Mary Walker ten dollars I do also give and bequeath unto my daughter in law Sarah Walker ten dollars I do also give and bequeath unto William Walker son of my eldest son Wm Walker ten dollars I do also give and bequeath to William Walker son of my youngest son Amarew Walker ten dollars I do also give and bequeath to my beloved wife Susannah and my youngest daughter Susannah my

Cupboard, bureau, pots and vases, bedding, bed clothes and all my household goods and chattels with the exception of my Clock I further give and devise to my youngest son Amarew Walker his heirs and assigns all my messuages or tenements situated by and being in the County of Washington and State of Tennessee together with all my freehold Estate whatever to him, the said Amarew Walker his heirs and assigns forever I do also give and bequeath to my son Amarew Walker my Clock and my part of the Waggon my beloved wife Susannah Walker if living at my death is to live with the said Amarew Walker the said Walker is to give my wife Susannah a plentiful and comfortable support and to take good care of her the said Susannah if there

is any of my Estate remaining not mentioned in this Will after all my debts are paid and expenses in life and at death of me and my wife Susannah shall be paid in some convenient way and divided equally among all my heirs whom I here by appoint sole executors of this my last Will and testament in witness where of I have hereunto set my hand and seal in the year of our Lord published

Signed sealed and declared by the above named William Walker to be his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who at his request and at his presence have hereunto subscribed our names as witness to the same

I further add to this Will

I give and bequeath to my wife Susannah and my youngest daughter Susannah the one half of my stock of Sheep and I give and bequeath to my youngest son Amarew Walker the other half of my stock of Sheep

I give and bequeath to my wife Susannah and to my youngest daughter Susannah one half of my stock of Pigs I give and bequeath to my youngest son Amarew the other half of my stock of Pigs

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th day of August in the year of our Lord
