Bains four tracts and all the bed clothing belonging to said Bedsteads one Cupboard one chest wazely one atomas of Bed with their increase fifteen head of hog (Thirdly) I will and bequeath to my beloved son Jesse J. Bains all the right title and begin then I have on a certain tract or parcel of Land then decreed to me by heirship from my Brother Nathan Jones lying in the County of Washington and State of Tennessee described and bounded as follows viz

H. Grouches line thence South 3/4 of a degree East along with his line 38 poles to a stake his corner Thence South 89 1/2 degrees West along said Grouches line 13 1/2 poles to a stake near the road Thence South 25 degrees West along the road 40 poles to the Beginning corner together with all the appertinances to have and to hold unto him the said Jesse J. Bains his heirs and assigns forever & the said Elizabeth Bains as a married man here and assigns will warrant & defend the title to said land or any part thereof against all persons whatsoever and every I do hereby constitute and appoint Jesse J.
