The last will & testament of David Beals
I David Beals of Washington County Tennessee
being weak in body but of sound ^{mind} calling to
mind the uncertainty of life & the certainty of
death it being appointed for all men once to
die do make & publish this my last will & testament
lawfully & making void all other wills by
me at any other time made

Firstly I will and bequeath that after my death
my body be decently buried and my funeral
expences and all my just debts be paid and
of any money I may have on hand at the
time of my death or that may come into the
hands of my executor or soon after my death
as possible

Secondly I will and bequeath to my beloved wife
Elizabeth all my moveable property viz my
household & kitchen furniture all my stock
farming utensils grain on hand & crop in the
ground and all the land I leave to her during
her widowhood or as long as she remains my
widow but in case she should have many I will
that she passers all the above land and property
during her natural lifetime but I leave it obligatory
on my widow for the use of the above property
to give to my three sons mainly Marshall Beals
Wm. Beals & Wm. M. Beals an outfit of a horse
saddle & bridle of a middle quality and my
three daughters Abigail Nancy & Martha
each with a good feather bed & bed steer & bed clothes
and she is to school & otherwise provide for all the
aforesaid children as long as they remain with
her in a family capacity

Thirdly I will and bequeath that after the death
or marriage of my wife that my land be
equally divided between my three sons Marshall
Wm. & Wm. M. Beals by them paying to my three
daughters Abigail Nancy & Martha each one
hundred dollars to be paid to the aforesaid
girls in one year after the see ~~boys~~

are entitled the possession of the sea land
Fourthly All the Cash & Cash notes and accounts that
I may have on hand at the time of my death
I wish to be applyed to the settlement of all my
just debts & liabilities and the remainder I direct
to be paid to my widow to assist her in schooling
and supporting the family
Fifthly I will & bequeath that my sons Thomas
David Samuel Caleb Jacob Isaac H. & Strawn
Beals & my daughters Hannah Rachel Elizabeth
Catharine & Jerusha be each allowed to keep what
I have hitherto given them and that is to stand
as their several portions of my estate both real &
personal

Sixthly I will and direct that my legatees & appoint
my wife Elizabeth & her brother Wm. Hutchins to
my Executors to carry this will into effect
In testimony whereof I do to this my last will
& testament set my hand and seal in my own hand
writing this 30th day of August 1857
Signed & seald in witness whereof
in our presence this 30th day of
August 1857
