daughter of Martin Adams. One bed, & bed-
stead & necessary bed clothing - now in pos-
session of my husband James Box.

3rd It do my will and desire that all the
residue of my property money and effects
not otherwise set apart to be equally divided
between John Box Hodges, G. W. Hodges the
heirs of Elizabeth Shanks, and the heirs of
Orlinda Jacobine Adams wife of Martins
Adams, that is to be divided in Four
equal parts.

4th Lastly I constitute and appoint Fred
Devane (Son of Sam. Devane) Executor
to this my last will and Testament, and
instruct him that out of the first money
that come to his hands that he pay and
discharge all debts and necessary funeral
expenses. And that my executors be allowed
to enter upon his duties without bond.
