

Nancy M. Cox - Will.

In the name of God Amen.

I, Nancy M. Cox being of sound mind and disposing memory, knowing that it is appointed to all to die and feeling that the time of my demise is near at hand, I commend my soul to God who gave it, and dispose of my worldly effects in the following manner to wit:

1st It is my will and desire that my Brother G. W. Hodges to have one Bed and bedstead and necessary bed clothing which is now in possession of my husband James Cox.

2nd I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Adams daughter of Martin Adams. One bed, & bedstead & necessary bed clothing - (now in possession of my husband James Cox).

3rd It is my will and desire that all the residue of my property money and effects not otherwise set apart to be equally divided between John C. C. Hodges, G. W. Hodges the heirs of Elizabeth Shanks, and the heirs of Orlena Josephine Adams wife of Martin Adams, that is to be divided in four equal parts.

4th Lastly I constitute and appoint Fred Devane (Son of Saml. Devane) Executor to this my last will and Testament, and instruct him that out of the first money that come to his hands that he pay and discharge all debts and necessary funeral expenses. And that my executor be allowed to enter upon his duties without bond.
