

James M. Fulkerson Will

In the name of God Amen I James M. Fulkerson of the County of Washington and State of Tennessee being of sound mind and memory and in view of the uncertainty of human life and being desirous of settling my worldly affairs.

Do make and publish this my last will and Testament in the manner following to wit.

1st my will is that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my death as can conveniently be my Executor.

Item 2nd I give devise and bequeath to my son Gregory W. Crockett Fulkerson all my Real Estate consisting of the farm on which I live containing about two thousand & thirty four acres being situated in the 7th Civil Dist of Washington Tenn and joining the lands of Jasper Dikes, V. B. Hunt, Dethers and my said son are to pay to my son Elihu Fulkerson the sum of Three hundred dollars in good money and to my daughter Virginia Dices formerly Virginia Fulkerson one horse to be worth seventy five dollars one hundred dollars in money said sums to be paid within one year from my death and further that my said son are to take care of my beloved wife (the deceased) Nancy Fulkerson during her life.

Item 3rd I will and bequeath to my said son Gregory W. Crockett all the personally properties of which I may die possessed of consisting of horses cattle - sheep hogs and Gregory is to have my guns and tools my said son Gregory & Crockett are to have all of the farm products & farming implements that are on hands at my death.

Item 4th and to my beloved wife Nancy Fulkerson I will and bequeath all my house hold and kitchen furniture consisting all in the house except the guns which I give to Gregory as aforesaid.

Lastly I do name and appoint my son Gregory to be the executor of this my last will and Testament.
