

James Hall Will

Style of James Hall, I James Hall a resident of the state and County Washington County, do here by make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking all and making and all others willed by me at any time heretofore. It is my will and I hereby that my funeral expenses and all just and lawful claims against my estate as soon after my death as practicable and of any money that I may die possessed or may find come into the hands of my Executor.

Second, I give and bequeath to my son Ebenezer Hall a tract of land lying in the 11th Civil Dist of Washington Co Penn bounded as follows. Beginning at a planted rock on the south bank of the Walaga river corner to Samuel Hall with his line South 16 W. 207 poles to a planted rock on Snyders line with his line 3.87 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 37 poles to a solid rock on top of a cliff thence down the cliff South 18 poles to a Sycamore tree down the river to the beginning the same being a part of the farm on which I now live and it is my will and I hereby direct that the said Ebenezer Hall pay or secure to be paid into the hands of my Executor the sum of three hundred and seventy five dollars for the benefit of my three daughters.

Third, I bequeath to my son Samuel Hall a tract of land lying in the 11th Civil Dist of ~~Penn~~ County bounded as follows Beginning at a planted rock corner to Grace Goad with a line of the same S. 24 W. 13 poles to a planted rock thence N. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a planted rock on Nathaniel Halls line with his line S. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 214 poles to a planted rock on Snyders line with his line 3.87 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 78 poles to a planted rock corner to Ebenezer Hall with his line N. 16 E. 209 poles on bank of river thence down the river to the beginning the same being a part of the land on which I now live and it is my will and I hereby direct that the said Samuel Hall pay or secure to be paid to my Executor the sum of 375 $\frac{1}{2}$ for the benefit of my three daughters.

Fourth, - I give and bequeath to my son Robert Hall a tract of land in the 11th Dis Dist of ~~Penn~~ County bounded as follows Beginning at a Beach on the south bank of Walaga river thence N. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 28 poles to a planted rock S. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 31 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a white oak S. 87 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 16 poles to a planted rock S. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 91 poles to a planted rock N. 87 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 91 poles to a hickory S. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 100 poles to a planted rock on Snyders line with his line S. 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 58 poles to a planted rock Nathaniel Halls corner with his line North 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 233 poles to a planted rock near an apple tree on bank of river thence down the river to the beginning the same being a part of the land on which I now live and it is my will and I hereby direct that the said Robert Hall pay or secure to be paid to my Executor the sum of

1375 $\frac{1}{2}$ for the benefit of my three daughters.

Fifth, I give and bequeath to my son Nathaniel Hall a tract of land lying in the 11th Civil Dist of ~~Penn~~ County, bounded as follows. Beginning at a planted rock on the bank of the Walaga river corner to Robert Hall with his line S. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 233 poles to a planted rock Snyder corner with his line S. 87 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 74 poles to a planted rock Samuel Halls corner with his line N. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 223 poles to a planted rock on bank of river thence down the river with its meanderings 72 poles to beginning the same being a part of the lands on which I now live and including the Mansion Barn and out buildings and it is my will and I hereby direct that the said Nathaniel Hall pay or secure to be paid to my Executor the sum of 375 $\frac{1}{2}$ for the benefit of my three daughters and in consideration of the fact that I have given to the said Nathaniel Hall the Mansion and out buildings it is my will that he furnish and provide a reasonable and comfortable support for my daughters Elizabeth and Sarah Jane as long as they remain single further that said daughters Elizabeth and Sarah J shall have for furniture of two rooms in the Mansion house one of which shall be a room with fire place and also the privilege of cooking in the kitchen so long as they may remain single it is further my will that if my daughter Sarah Jane shall die without heirs of her body all property which may belong to her shall revert to and be the property of my son Nathaniel Hall Sixth, I hereby direct my Executor to give to my daughter Elizabeth a certain Catt which she claims and also a cow and one bed together with all the bed clothing she herself has made also one Cabinet one table one set of chairs and such cooking utensils as will make her equal to those I furnished her married Carter Abby Friday and to my daughter Sarah J. he shall pay the sum of 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ in lieu of Catt and Cow given my other daughter also two beads and to my son Nathaniel Hall one Desk.

Seventh. - I direct my Executor to sell all the remainder of my personal property and divide the proceeds equally between all my heirs. - Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint John H. Saunders of the C of Sullivan my Executor in witness whereof of God to this my will set my hand and seal on this 1st day of September 1886.
