

Archy Mc'Inturff's Will.

I Archy Mc'Inturff do make and publish this as my last will and hereby revoking and making void all other wills by me at any time made.

First. I direct that my funeral expenses & all my debts, be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any monies that I may die seized and possessed of, or may first come into the hands of my executors.

Secondly. I give and bequeath unto Serphina Allen my daughter, and wife of Robt. Allen, an amount equal to what my other children may each receive from their fathers Estate -

Thirdly. The balance of my estate I will, to be equally divided among all my children, equally share and share alike, that is after Serphina Allen before named receives an amount to make her equal to what my other children may receive from the estate of my husband Gabriel Mc'Inturff dec'd -

Lastly, I hereby nominate and appoint and appoint Calvin Hoss my executor - to this my last will and testament, in witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this 6th day of March 1855.

James Tinkers. Will.

I James Tinker do make and publish this as my last will and testament, hereby revoking and making void, all other wills, by me at any time made.

First. I direct that my funeral expenses and all my debts, be paid as soon after my death, as possible, out of any monies that I may die possessed of, or may first come into the hands of my executors -

Secondly. I give and bequeath to my wife Nancy Tinker the balance of my personal property after my debts are paid to have and hold, during her life, in which she may remain a widow -

Thirdly. I give and bequeath to my son Bill P. and Jessie P. Tinker, all lands that I may possess of, to have and hold for ever, subject to the following restrictions viz that the aforesaid Bill P. and Jessie P. Tinker, pay me one third of the proceeds of 52 land for the support of the aforesaid Nancy Tinker, during her life or widow hood and also for the support of minor heirs, and, to pay to each his fifty dollars due at their mother's death -

Fourthly. It is my will and desire that my daughters have a home on the farm, as long as they live, and conduct them selves in an upright & respectful manner.

Fifthly. I give and bequeath to my son Jessie P. Tinker the sum of seventy five dollars, to make him equal to an amount heretofore given to my other children -

Lastly. I do hereby nominate and appoint Philip P. and Jessie P. Tinker, my Executors - In witness whereof I do to this my will, set my hand and seal - this 1st day of May 1866.)
