

Will of Christian Sligar made 15th July 1865

Approved in Minutes of August Term of County Court

Will

I Christian Sligar do make and publish my last will and Testament.

First I do direct that my funeral expenses and all my debts be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any money that I may be possessed of or may first come into the hands of my executor.

2nd I direct that all my real estate be sold and divided equal among my children.

3rd that all my personally property be sold and divided among the above.

4 I direct that Margaret E. Sligar my grand daughter for nursing on me have thirty dollars.

5 I direct that Joseph of Leola for his care of me have one hundred dollar.

6 I direct that my last wife Rachel legal heir have one large chest one long closet one cupboard one table one pair of bedstead one feather bed one Shaw tick one blanket two coverlets & two pillows.

7 I direct that all my money that is in Adam Sligar Jr hands for the sale of land, be collected and divided equal among the heirs.

Lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint Montgomery O. Spring my executor in writing whereof I do to this will set my hand & seal this 15 day of July 1865

Will of Stephen Moore made 28th day of May 1856

With Codicil dated 2nd day of July 1860. Approved in the Minutes of County Court August Term 1865

" I Stephen Moore of the County of Washington & State of Tennessee do make & publish this my last will & testament in manner & form following

Section 1st It is my will that my funeral expenses be paid out of any money on hand or that may first come into the hands of my executor.

Sec² I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Moore the entire Control of my estate both real and personal (whilst she may remain my widow) except what may be hereafter named, but if she should marry again she is to have a child's part, but it is my sincere desire that she should remain my widow and stay with the children to raise and give them proper instruction both temporal & spiritual.

Sec³ It is my will that when any of the children should marry that my wife be portioned them in the same way that my daughter Elizabeth was.

Sec⁴ It is my will that my widow and children all live together until they marry and manage get along as well as the nature of the case will admit, and if there should be more stock on hand than will be necessary to carry the farm & for the support of the family my executor is authorized to sell the same either public or private and apply the proceeds to the use of the family.

Sec⁵ It is my will that my children be sent to school as much as will be convenient, my aim is to learn to read write and cipher through the English rule of three.

Sec⁶ It is my will that at my wife's death (if she remains my widow) all my estate both real & personal be equally divided among all my children viz. Elizabeth McVee Jane Catherine, Russell Alex. Crawford Amanda, Stephen Michael Conaly, Andrew & if any to be equal shares. My sons each to have a \$500 when they come of age.

Lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my brother Moses Moore Executor & my wife executrix of this my last will and testament. Witness my hand and seal this 28th day of May 1856

"A. Codicil to this my last will and testament, in Sec⁶ of the above will where it speaks of an equal division among all the children. Will of Christy Bashne made
April 28th 1865. Approved on Minutes of the
County Court August Term 1865

I Christy Bashne of Washington County Tennessee do make and publish this my last will and Testament

Section 1 I will that my executors hereafter named shall pay all my just debts out of any money or assets that I may possess also pay my funeral expenses

Section 2 My will is that my son John Bashne have the farm on which I now live and possess, in case he should return from the war. And if he never return my will is that my son in law D. H. Dore is to have the farm, and whenever get possession of the land is to pay out to the other heirs one hundred dollars per annum, beginning at my daughter Anna the first payment, the second to my daughter Margaret, the third to my son Thomas Childs and so on until five hundred dollars each is paid without interest and the land to stand good for the above payments until all is paid, and if my son Isaac Childs, should not live till all his five hundred dollars is paid, then my will is that the remaining money is equal divided among the three other heirs

Section 3 I will the Meeting house that I built on the place to the Rev. Amos Rappah or his heirs and land sufficient for roads leading to and from Church. My will is that the Deeds of all description that I own for the Meeting house be and remain with and for the use of the Meeting house

Section 4 My will is that the debts and accounts that I owe against the heirs be settled and deducted out of the five hundred dollars. And all the accounts I may get hereafter. Section 5 My will is that all my loose property, such as farming utensils house hold and kitchen furniture Bee sold and the money equal divided among the heirs

Section 6 My will is that my son Isaac widow is that

have home room and other privileges such as are past to and garden, and also that she should receive to that she does not suffer My will is that this be ended to as long as she remains my son Isaac's widow, the one that gets the farm has this to do to

Section the 7 My will is that if any of the heirs should become dissatisfied with the aforesaid will and go to law they must pay all costs and expenses themselves and not the estate

Section 8 I hold five hundred dollars Stock in the S. Penn & Va R. Road which I want equal divided among my heirs. Section the 9 My will is that all of my son Isaac's things is to be his widow

Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint John Walters & D. H. Dore my son in law executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills by me made, acknowledged and subscribed to before us this April 28th 1865

Christy Bashne

Will of Peter Miller made September
1863. Approved on minutes of the Court September Term 1864

I Peter Miller of the County of Washington being of sound mind and disposing judgment do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in the manner and form following

Sec 1st I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of the first money that may come into the hands of my executors or out of any money that I may die possessed of as soon as possible

Sec 2nd It is my will that my son Solomon Miller and my daughter Mary Ann Eakin have the farm on which I live to be equally divided between them and that my daughter Delila Humphreys have four hundred Dollars, which four hundred dollars shall be paid to her by my son Solomon Miller and my daughter Mary Ann Eakin two hundred dollars each to be paid in twelve months after my decease, which money shall be paid in whatever money is the currency of the country when it is due

3rd It is my will that my wife Mary Miller have a decent support from the farm on which I live, during her life, and after the death of my wife Mary Miller and her funeral expenses paid it is my will that my daughter Mary Ann Eakin have all my personal effects both in the house and out of doors, whatever money may remain
