ding provided I do furnish Bed and Bedding before my  
death. She has One and Extra Good Bird and deserves  
good pay the above is my will and it shall stand ag  
ainst Law and Equity This 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1879

The first will and testament of Sallie Jane Miller of  
Washington County Tennessee.

I Sallie Jane Miller of the County  
of Washington and State of Tennessee being of sound mind and  
memory but weak in body realizing the uncertainty of this life  
do make ordain publish and declare this to be my last will and  
testament hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time  
made or published.

First - I give my soul unto God who gave it  
my body I commit to the earth to be interred in Christian like  
manner -

Second. It is my will and desire that all  
my just debts be paid by my Executor hereinafter to be named

Thirdly. I will give and devise to Matilda  
Reeves the wife of Peter H Reeves my bedding & clothes belonging  
to the same

Fourth. I will give and devise to Mary -  
Reeves wife of Wm P Reeves all my silver ware

Fifth. I will give and devise unto Mary  
Patterson wife of St. J. Patterson all my claims

Sixth. I will give and devise unto Lizzie  
A Reeves all my silk ware of all kinds

Seventh. It is my will that my Executor  
sell the balance of my personal property together with my  
real estate

Eighth. I will give and devise unto my  
four sisters Elizabeth Jane Martha Rosal Mary Koops and Margaret  
Ann Wilson all that I received from my Father's Estate supposed  
to be four hundred dollars if it should lack a sum to be made  
to that amount from the sale of other property and divided into  
four equal parts of one hundred each & paid to each one of the  
above named sisters

Ninth. I will give and devise unto the  
Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal church at Johnson City one  
thousand dollars out of any money I may have for the erection  
of a church building at said town & direct my Executor to pay  
the same out for that purpose

Tenth. I will give and devise any balance  
if any ~~money~~ there may be to be equally divided by my Executor
