me with. Do make this my last will and testament, having

Section 1st. I will and bequeath to my Grand daughter Lou-
rena Russell daughter of Amanda Helen Dead and the Heirs of
her body the East part of my house and lot where I now
live in Jonesboro bounded by water Street lesser property
A. E. Jackson & C. W. Fink. The dividing line to run through
between the Kitchen and dwelling house and a straight line
through from water Street to A. E. Jackson fence or line and
so as to include all the dwelling house and lot East
of said line. This house and lot shall be held by my
said Grand daughter Lourena Russell during her
natural life free from the control of her husband and
at her death shall go to the heirs of her body.
Section 2nd I will and bequeath to my said Grand

of every description, consisting of house hold and
Kitchen furniture Notes money or other assets of
my estate. But it is intended, ~~that~~ it and I so order
that the real & personal property herein will be
to said Lourena shall be for her sole and separate
