I Nelly Helen of Jonesboro Washington County, New Jersey
 being old and feeble, but of sound mind and memory, knowing
 that according according to nature I cannot expect to live long
 and wishing in answer of each property as God has blessed
 me with. do make this my last will and testament, firm-
 ly resolving and making said all other wills by me at any
 time heretofore made.

Section 1st. I will and bequeath to my Grand daughter Lau-
 rena Russell daughter of Amanda Helen Wood and the Heirs of
 her body the East part of my house and lot where I now
 live in Jonesboro bounded by water Street Leaven property
 A. E. Jackson + R. W. Fisk. The dividing line to run through
 between the kitchen and dwelling house and a straight line
 through from water street to A. E. Jackson field or line so
 as to include all the dwelling house and lot East
 of said line. This house and lot shall be held by my
 said Grand daughter Laurena Russell during her
 natural life free from the control of her husband and
 at her death shall go to the heirs of her body.

Section 2nd. I will and bequeath to my said Grand
 daughter Laurena Russell all my personal property
 of every description, consisting of house hold and
 kitchen furniture Notes money or other assets of
 my estate. But it is intended, ~~that~~ it and I so order
 that the real + personal property hereby willed
 to said Laurena shall be for her sole and separate
 use free from the control of her husband, and at her
 death shall go to the heirs of her body but in no
 case shall she be allowed to sell said lot or her
 said interest and when she shall see proper to leave
 said property and not live in it then it shall go to
 her heirs and the rents and profits shall be for their use
 equally.

Section 3rd I will and bequeath to my daughter
 Laurena Russell the remainder of my lot including
 the kitchen and running with a straight line from -
 water Street through between the kitchen and dwelling
 house back to Jacksons line all of said lot West of said
 line to hold enjoy and control to her own separate
 sole use + benefit as long as she may live and at
