(Main Brogys Will)

In the name of God Amen the twentieth day of June One Thousand Seven hundred
and eighty two I Eleazar Brogys being sick of body but of good and perfect memory
do thank be to almighty god and calling to remembrance the uncertainty estate of this
transitory life and that all flesh must yield to death when it shall please god to
call me home this and all that I have do hereby will and bequeath in manner and
form following I do first being pinched and sorry for all my sins most humbly desiring
forgiveness for the same I commend my soul to almighty god my saviour & redeemer in
whom I have full trust to be saved and to have full
remission of all my sins and to inhabit the heavenly Jerusalem and my body I commend
to the earth to be buried here at the execution of my executor hereafter named &
of the settling of my temporal estate — and such good Charters and debts as it
shall please god to bestow on me I do leave you and dispose thereof as I have in manner
and form following that is to say I do first praying all my lawfull debts
and Bequeaths to my son Eleazar Brogys my first born son two hundred acres of land out of the
land I have Eleazar Brogys only son Joseph Ballard on the South side of the
river of the same more or less to my sons Aaron and Joshua Brogys the land I
now have I bequeath to them to be equally divided to them I bequeath to my daughter
Milla the two hundred acres of land he said Eleazar Brogys bought of George
Doherty he the same more or less and five Shillings Sterling then I bequeath to
Muma my first daughter the sum of five pounds in the year yearly or at the
execution of my will I do give to my son Aaron he is married till the time of
his death he and his heirs and assigns have and enjoy at the time of his marriage
the sum of five pounds yearly

Do hereby bequeath More or less and five Shillings Sterling then I bequeath to
Mama Joseph and Maria and her children to be paid in the year ending at the
quarter of the year sooner and when from the 1st of March till the time of
bequests and the said and when there are a cow and calf at the time of her Marriages
and two pots and a duck even and to my daughter Mary Broyles I bequeath to her
twenty pounds of this currency but and elsewhere one cow and calf two pots and one
duck even the family is to live on said plantation he now lives on while on
Mexico and the whole of the remaining estate to be equally divided at the year ending
at the expiration of the executor's wages and the land and all estate and of
any of these by law should die without an heir there part shall be equally divided
among the rest and to my daughter Anne Brown I leave five Shillings Sterling
And I hereby make and appoint my loving friends Joseph Brown Moses Broyles
and William Moore full and sole executors of this my last will & testament
lawfully revoking disannulling and making void all former wills by me made &
declaring this only to be my last will and testament in writing whereof we
have hereunto set our hands and seals this nineteenth day of April one thousand
seven hundred and eighty two
