I David Matlock of the county of Washington & State of North Carolina being advanced in years and in a low state of health yet of sound memory blessed by God yet willing to meet the Mortality of my body & that it is appropriate for all men here to do so make and ordain this my last will and testament - first of all I commend my soul into the hands of almighty God who gave it and my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of my executors hereafter named nothing doubting but at the general resurrection the same shall be raised by the same almighty power which brought them into existence and as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased almighty god to bless me withal well and decree in the following manner (lawn) - I give and bequeath unto my three daughters that is Sarah Elizabeth & Catharine one feather bed and due saddle to each of them, I give and bequeath unto my young wife Margaret my plantation together with all my stock of every kind household furniture & implements of husbandry during her life or widowhood and at her death or marriage the plantation to be my son George and a horse to the value of twenty pounds and the rest of my estate to be equally divided between my sons David & Gideon and lastly I do appoint my son David and Joseph Green whole and sole executors of this my last will and testament - hereby disannulling & making void all other wills and testaments hitherto made by me and Establishing & confirming this as my last will & testament - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fifteenth day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and Ninety

and as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased almighty god to bless me with I
will and devise in the following manner (town) - I give and bequeath unto my
three daughters that is Sarah Elizabeth & Catherine one feather bed and sixe yards to each
of them I give and bequeath unto my young wife Margaret my plantation together
with all my share of every her household furniture & implements of husbandry during
her life her widowhood and at her death or marriage the plantation to her son George
and a horse to the value of twenty pounds and the rest of my estate to be equally
divided between my sons David & Gordon and lastly I do appoint my son David
and Joseph Green whole and sole executors of this my last will and testament
hence disannulling & making void all other wills and testaments hitherto made
by me and Establishing & confirming this as my last will & testament In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fifteenth day of March in the
year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety
