of the territory of the United States of America south of the river Ohio

Washington County - This sixteenth day of September One thousand seven hundred & Ninety five
 Edmund Williams of the County aforesaid being upon and busy before me of the Mortality of my body and
 memory of perfect mind & memory & having a mind to make and do in this my last will & testament that is to
 say principally and first of all I give and bequeath my soul into the hands of Almighty God who
 gave it and my body a tabernacle to the earth to be buried at the discretion of my executors and as
 touching such worldly estate wherewith I have been pleased to bless me in this life I give away &
 dispose of the same in the following manner & form (No 3)

I give unto my beloved wife Susannah Williams One Negro Woman named Linah one horse bridle
 and saddle one feather bed and furniture a cow & calf & one black one tallow and all the pasture
 and stable furniture two cows & calves or quarterly two others the rest of hogs, fowls, head of Sheep
 I also leave to my beloved wife Susannah the following negroes to wit, Sandy & Davis with one
 half of the plantation I now live on during her life time —

I give to my son Joshua Williams and his wife Williams One Negro called Will partly also the
 Negro that Matthew Bap (now the late) did so agreeably between them —

I give unto my son George Williams the harness tools & drivers tools and one Negro named Jackey &c
 My wife deceased — I also I give also to my son Samuel Williams my land in Pleasant Valley also the
 & whatever comes or purchased for them when divided the said land being in the whole six hundred
 acres it being in three hundred and acre surveys — I also give unto my son Abraham
 Williams One Cow & Calf or yearling One Negro named Will by after my wife deceased

I give to my daughter Susanna Jackson or the heirs of her body lawfully begotten one negro

Acres it being in three hundred acres Survey — I also give unto my son Archibald
Williams One Cow & Calf or yearling One Negro named Willaby after my wife deceased
I give to my daughter Luanna Sutton or the heirs of her body lawfully begotten One Negro
Woman named Delila — I give to my daughter Wiphena Williams or the heirs
of her body lawfully begotten One Negro Girl named Phair One horse or Mare saddle
and bridle of the Value of eighty three dollars One Cow and Calf or yearling after my
wifes decease — I give to my daughter Sarah Adams Williams One Negro girl
named Melisa to her the said Sarah and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten also one
Cow and Calf or yearling and One horse or Mare bridle & saddle of the Value of eighty
three dollars — I give unto my son John Linday Williams three hundred and
thirty eight acres of land It being the lower part of a tract of land containing five hundred
acres on Buffalo Creek granted to Edmund Williams by ~~Matthew~~^{Matthew} Gardner by deed bearing
date the twenty second of October One thousand seven hundred and eighty two I also give
unto the said John at his Mothers decease four hundred and four acres of land on
Buffalo Creek adjoining the other land This being a part of a Survey of six hundred &
forty acres granted to Edmund Williams by ~~Matthew~~^{Matthew} from the state of North Carolina
bearing date the twenty third day of October One thousand seven hundred and eighty two
also thirty six acres of land lying opposite to the house on the North side of Buffalo
Creek and if John should decease before he is twenty one years of age without leaving
a living son lawfully begotten then the whole of the aforesaid John land to be given to
Archibald Williams and my land left not willed away is to be sold at the direction
of the executors and escheat all undivided amongst my children —
and the Money that is due Edmund Williams by Samuel Duck William Grahams & John McNaughe to be equally
divided amongst my children —

The aforesaid John Lindsey Williams is not to have possession of the less until he becomes
of twenty one years old I also give unto my son John Lindsey Williams two Negroes one
Named Sandy and the other and the other Name after his Mother deceased and bearing of age
that is to say twenty one years old and if John Should die before he becomes of twenty one
years of age or leave a lawful issue then Sandy & Davis shall be sold by the executors
and the Money equally divided amongst my children —

I also give my son Samson thirty pounds of feathers —

Also Richardson thirty pounds of feathers for a bed —

Also my daughter Sophia thirty pounds of feathers for a bed —

Also my daughter Sarah thirty pounds of feathers for a bed —

Also my son John thirty pounds of feathers for a bed —

I constest and appoint my son Joshua Williams of Parmenter County and State of
North Carolina one of the executors of this my last will and testament also my
son Richardson Williams my other executor of Washington County & Territory
of the United States of America south of the river Ohio of this my last
will and testament and I do hereby wholly disallow revoke & disannul
all and every other former testaments and do ratify and confirm this my last
will and testament — In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal the day and year above written — Signed sealed published pronounced
and declared by me the said Edmund Williams as his last will & testament
in presence of us the subscribers —

Carpenters tools and the like for the use of the family and the horses not called
Nor hogs to be sold only at the discretion of the executor the sheep there also are
to be divided amongst my children This Schedule to be adjudged to be a part &
parcel of my last will and testament and that all things therein mentioned and
contained be faithfully and truly performed and fully & amply in every respect as
if the same were so declared as set down in my said last will & testament -
witness my hand this sixteenth day of September one thousand seven hundred
and ninety five

The foregoing will was proven in court by the Oathes of -
William Davis Charles Whiston & William Williams the subscribing witnesses
thereto at November Sessions 1795 & Ordained to be recorded -
Joshua Williams and Archabald Williams qualified as executors of the
foresaid will
