

James Gallcher Will

In the name of God Amen

September 22^d day 1791 I James Gallcher in Washington County on the western waters living on Molechuckty near being sick in body but of good and perfect Memory Thanks be to the Almighty God and calling to remembrance the uncertain state of this transitory life and that all flesh must yield to death when it shall please god to call us make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following I first being penitent and sorry for all my sins most humbly desiring forgiveness for the same I commend my soul to the Almighty God my Saviour & Redeemer in whom and by whose merits I trust and believe to be saved eternally and to have full remission for all my sins and to inherit the Kingdom of Heaven and my body I commit to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors hereafter named and for the settling of my temporal estate and such good Chances and debts as it hath pleased god to bestow upon me I do Order you and dispose the same in manner and form following that is to say I do hereby allow all my lawfull debts to be paid George Thomas & James Gallcher have got their whole and full share and Sarah Gallcher my loving wife to live on this plantation on which they are now until the Youngest Son David Gallcher is of age & then to make an equal division And I hereby make and appoint my loving wife Sarah Gallcher and George and John Gallcher full and sole executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking annulling and making void all former wills & request be me made and declaring this only to be my last will & testament & the writing bearing I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and year first above written -
