1846 To the worshipped the County Court of
Washington County.

Having been entrusted by the Court
House Commissioners with the duty of
expending the extra appropriation of one
thousand dollars, under the instructions
contained in their written authority of the
9th April 1846. I deem it proper to present
a report showing what disposition has
been made of it.

Annexed is an account showing
how the money is expended, and I herewith
submit for the inspection of the worship-
ful Court all the original Contracts and
accounts and request that this report
may be accepted and approved and spread
upon your minutes 5th October 1847.
