

This Indenture made This 27th day of March 1841 between William Mosley of Meckley County Tennessee of the one part and Thos E Mosley Elizabeth Cole wife of Mosen E Cole and her children John W. Rogers and Thos L Cole & George B Mosley William Mosely Green Mosley Rebecca J. Ausburn, ~~Hillery Mosley~~ wife of William Ausburn Hillery Mosley & William G. Mosley Mary A Mosley Moses Mosley Martha Mosley & Hillery Mosley the last five are children of Arthur Mosley all of the County of the County of Meckley except the children of Arthur Mosley those of Gibson County Tennessee of the second part. Witnesseth that for the natural love and affection I bear to my children and grand children above named and the consideration that they support and their mother and grand mother Martha Mosley during our natural life I have this day bargained sold and delivered to them and their heirs and assigns the following property to wit: one tract of land lying in Meckley County containing Six hundred and forty acres it being the tract of land whereon I live granted to Henry A Coleman one negro man named Washington one Negro man by the name Christopher one negro boy John one negro boy Leagen one negro boy named Daniel Negro woman named Betty one negro woman named Mary one negro girl named Joanna also three head of horses also Eight head of cattle also one

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waggon and three yoke of oxen also about fifty head of hogs also fifteen head of sheep also a second tract of land lying in the County of Gibson Tennessee containing Six hundred & forty acres whereon I think Mosley now lives purchased of the said Henry A Coleman. To have and to hold the same aforesaid property to them the sd. Thos E. Mosley Elizabeth Cole John W. Rogers Thos L. Cole George B Mosley William Mosley Green Mosley Rebecca J. Ausburn Hillery Mosley William G. Mosley Mary A Mosley Moses Mosley Martha Mosley and Hillery Mosley their heirs and assigns and the said William Mosley covenanting with the aforesaid parties that he warrants and defends the titles to them of the aforesaid property against the claim of all and every person whatsoever

Know all men by these presents that we John C. Dadd Saml Taylor Thomas Parkman and William S. Scott all of the County and State aforesaid are firmly bound unto said Governor of the State of Tennessee for the time being and his successor in office

The sum of ten thousand dollars which payment well and truly to be made we each of us bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally and firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this the 4th day of April 1842

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound John C. Dadd was on the 1st day of March last elected clerk of the County Court of said Weakly County for a term of four years now should be the said Dadd clerk aforesaid well and truly collect all the County and State Revenue which may be due which by the tenor of his office is his duty to collect and pay the same over to the proper authorities according to law then this obligation to be null and void otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue

Jones Governor of the State of Tenn. for the time being and his successor in office in the sum of two thousand dollars which payment well and truly to be made we and each of us bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally and firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this the 6th day of June 1842

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound The Hall Duff and Collector of public Taxes for Weakly County having this day received of the Court the tax book for 1842 - Now should he well and truly collect and pay over to the proper authorities authorized to receive the same all the State revenue due and owing the State of Tennessee from Weakly County as set forth in said tax book made out by the clerk of the County Court and received by him this day then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
