John S. Rhea's Will.

In the name of God, Amen,

I John S. Rhea of the County of White and State of Tennessee, being feeble in body but of disposing mind and memory make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all Wills by me at any time made:

- 1st I bequeath my soul to God who gave it and my body to the earth to be decently interred under the directions of my Executors,
- 2^d I desire that all my just debts be paid as soon after my death as possible.
- 3^d I give and bequeath to my beloved wife A. J. Rhea my house and lot in Sparta, known as the Rhea Place the same which I now occupy as a residence with all the furniture and fixtures belonging to the same during her natural life or widowhood, with the right and power to sell the same and make title thereto as my Executor upon such time as she may deem proper and use the proceeds first for the support of herself and minor children for which purpose she is hereby appointed testamentary Guardian of my said minor children and it is my desire that she act as such Guardian without bond and after supporting herself and my said minor children to so distribute the remainder among all my children in any manner she may think proper taking into consideration their necessities. In the event my wife should marry and said Place properly should remain unsold I desire the same to be rented or sold by my Executors and in this event I empower my Executors (aside from my wife) to make title by regular conveyance if they should sell and if they should rent, to rent out and receive and collect the rents and divide the proceeds in either event equally giving my wife an equal share, share and share alike with her and each of the children.
- 4th I desire my Executors to sell the remainder of my real estate to the best advantage either on time or for Cash for the purpose of paying my debts and hereby confer power on them to make conveyances of said real estate by deed of conveyance for the purpose of paying my debts and for distribution as herein provided of my surplus that may remain after the payment of my just liabilities; I also direct that my policy of two thousand dollars as a Knight of Honor together with the remainder of my personal effects of every character and description not herein specially bequeathed be appropriated if necessary to the payment of my indebtedness and if any surplus should remain to be paid to my wife in her own right and as Guardian of my children who should then be minors, the equal share of said surplus each child taking an equal share with my wife and the children who may be of age to pay their equal share.
- 5th In the event of the marriage or death of my wife, I desire my son Mr. E. Rhea and my brother-in-law A. M. England to take the Guardianship of my children who may then be under age, and superintend their raising and education and distribute to each of them as they become of age or marry

whatsoever may be their proper proportion of my estate in an equal division among them

6th I nominate and appoint my wife A. J. Rhea my son A. B. Rhea and my brother-in-law A. M. England my Executors and Executrix to this my last Will without being required to give bond and in the event of the marriage of my wife her Executorship to cease, but not otherwise provided that if either one of them should die the survivors or survivor to continue to act in like manner as herein directed.
